Dear Parents

As part of your child's learning in Reception they will be going out to Forest School. We aim to get out for a minimum of six sessions every term.

Forest School allows your child time to experience and learn about the world in which they live.

The importance of children experiencing Forest School throughout the year is that it allows them to observe and learn about the changes in their natural environment.

Forest School is an integral part of the curriculum and therefore your child will be expected to join in.

Below I have provided a list of clothing your child will need for Forest School. Some of the items listed are dependent on the weather, but the rule is that the more layers the better prepared your child will be, as we can always remove layers!

It is important that the clothes they wear are not new or expensive clothes as we want to children to get involved in Forest School and this can get muddy.

All Year:

Waterproof Jacket/Coat

Wellington Boots or suitable footwear

Summer:

Light weight long sleeved tops

Light weight long trousers.

Sun hat



****Please note- Shorts and t-shirts are not appropriate as children can get scratched by the longer grasses.**

Colder Months:

Warm socks

Trousers (not jeans)

Waterproof trousers

Plenty of layers for top part of the body (to include a vest)

Fleece, sweatshirt, jumper, hoody

Gloves, hat & scarf
