

Literacy:

A range of stories based on fairy tales and magic, traditional tales, instructions, letters, descriptive writing, diary writing, role play.



Texts including George's Marvellous Medicine, Paper Bag Princess, Winnie the Witch, Tinkerbelle, Jolly Postman, Grimm's Fairy tales, Princess and the Wizard.

Science:

Materials, physical properties, everyday uses, changes in shape, absorbency.

Thinking scientifically, creating simple investigations, making predictions and writing conclusions.

Numeracy:

Addition and subtraction, number problems, missing numbers, problem solving, multiplication tables (2's, 3's, 4's, 5's and 10's), doubles and halves, number bonds, money, shape, mental maths, inverse operations, division, capacity and reading scales, reasoning about number, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words.

PSHE:

Relationships, new beginnings, anti bullying.

Music:

Singing songs, playing instruments, creating our own music, exploring different genres.

RE:

Incarnation, Harvest, Diwali and Hanukah

P4C:

If you could grant one wish what would it be?

PE:

Dance, Gymnastics.

Art:

Jan Pieńkowski, drawing, illustrations, characters, silhouettes, fantasy creatures and castles.
