Year 2- SATS / General Information

Dear Parents/Carers

As your child is now settled into Year 2, Mrs Ashling and I would like to inform you of Year 2 assessment procedures and general reminders.

It is vitally important that you read with your child as often as you can and record this in their home/school diary. By the end of Year 2 children need to be reading with 90% accuracy and at a good pace.

They must be able to read, write and spell all Year 1 and Year 2 common exception words which are sent home as part of their weekly spelling test. (A copy is attached to this letter)

Year 2 children will sit a formal test in Reading (2 papers); Maths (2 papers) and Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar, also known as SPAG. This will be towards the end of May/beginning of June.

This will form **PART** of their end of year assessment.

Writing will be teacher assessed over the year. The children will cover many genres.

Attached to this letter are the KS1 interim statements. These statements show what your child should be achieving by the end of the year.

- For children to achieve the '**expected**' standard, they must show that they have met **all** of the '**working towards**' statements and **all** the '**expected**' statements.
- For children to achieve the '**greater depth**' standard, they **must** demonstrate that they have achieved **all** of the '**working towards**' statements, **all** of the '**expected**' statements and **all** of the '**greater depth**' statements.

This is over a range of work across the year.

The SAT tests scores will be used, along with teacher assessment, to form an overall judgment as to where your child is working.

Children in Year 2 should be achieving the 'expected' standard or above.
