KS2 Visit to Attingham Park- WW2 Day

Dear Parents,

In the second part of the summer term, KS2 have organised for the children to go to Attingham Park as part of their History work on World War 2. The programme is led by the National Trust staff and involves children learning about the lives and lifestyles of evacuees who arrived at Attingham Park through role-play activities. They will take part in a range of exciting activities which include experiencing and learning about: roll call, rationing, make do and mend (rag rugging), air raid drill and billeting.

Each class will be going on a separate day, the dates are as follows:

Tuesday 19th June 5EV

Friday 22nd June 4/5ST

Monday 2nd July 4BL

Wednesday 4th July 6AR

Thursday 5th July 3CRD

Friday 6th July 6CO

We will be leaving after morning registration and will be returning in time for the end of the school day.

To further enhance the learning experience, we would like the children to come **dressed as evacuees** for the trip. This can be as simple as a skirt, blouse and cardigan for girls and hair either in plaits or with a bow. Boys can wear shorts, shirts, tank tops and long socks. You may also like to make an identity tag and gas mask box (using an old shoe box) at home. Children will also need to bring a waterproof coat. Although most of the learning will be done inside the house, if the weather is dry, lunch will be eaten outside so if it is hot please also bring a sun hat and make sure sun cream is applied. Children will need to bring a **packed lunch and drinks** for the day- please no fizzy drinks or glass bottles. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, then a free packed lunch can be ordered- please indicate on the form if required. **NO** spending money will be required for the visit.

The cost of the day, including coach travel works out at £11:50 per child, however FOSLs have very kindly offered to subsidise the visit, so that it works out at £9:50 per child. This is a voluntary contribution, however should there be insufficient contributions the visit may have to be cancelled.

We are looking forward to what we know will be a very exciting and memorable visit.
